Regatta History

This regatta has its proud beginnings in 1988 by the Pine Harbor Yacht Club in Birmingham Alabama in honor of one of their members, Stan Wrobel. As this developed, others saw the merit of such an event and with the help of noted sailing expert and ESPN commentator Gary Jobson, the current format was developed by the Maryland Chapter of the Leukemia Society with their first "Leukemia Cup Regatta" in Annapolis. Enthusiasm for this event has spread across the country to forty-one chapters now participating what is now known as the **Volvo Leukemia Cup** Regatta Series

Volvo Leukemia Cup

This regatta is both a race and a fund raising competition. Sailors participating in the regatta are encouraged to collect contributions to help support research and patient care programs. In 1999, the Birmingham Sailing Club Volvo Leukemia Cup regatta attracted over 40 boats who raced on Logan Martin Lake and raised over \$21,000.
