**NOTICE OF RACE**  
123<sup>rd</sup> CYC Invitational Regatta – June 15 & 16  
Solstice Race – June 19  
The 73<sup>rd</sup> Commodore F.W. Roberts Race – June 21

**1. RULES**

- 1.1 All races will be governed by the 2001 – 2004 *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS); the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association (US SAILING); the rules of participating classes; except as any of these are changed by this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions and any amendments hereafter.
- 1.2 This Regatta is designated Category "A" for yachts so classified by their class, rating system or national authority and is designated Category "C" for yachts so classified by their class, rating system, national or international authority.
- 1.3 Special attention to participants of the rules of the RRS 2.2 (I.e requirement to read the rules of the event). By filing registration for these events you will be acknowledging that you agree to participate under the rules in the notice of race and sailing instructions.

**2. CHANGES IN THE RACING RULES OF SAILING**

The rules will be modified in accordance with rule 86.1(b) as follows:

- 2.1 Rule 41 is altered to allow the use of GPS and Loran for all boats on the Cruising Division courses.
- 2.2 Rule 44.2 is altered as follows for all boats on the Cruising Division courses, sailing on June 15<sup>th</sup> through 22<sup>nd</sup>, "After getting well clear of other boats as soon after the incident as possible, a boat takes a Penalty Turn by promptly making one complete 360 degree turn, including one tack and one gybe. When a boat takes a penalty at or near the finish line, she

- shall sail completely to the course side of the line before finishing.”
- 2.3 Rule 41 and rule 44.2 will be in effect without change for all classes sailing on the One-Design courses June 15 &16.
  - 2.4 Rule A2 of Appendix A is modified as set forth herein in Section 10, Scoring.

**3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The U-Store-It Lighthouse Series 2002 is open to all members of the Inter-Lake Yachting Association and it's member clubs, US SAILING members and member yacht clubs and sailing class associations that meet the conditions of the regatta notice of race.
- 3.2 One Design Series will be offered for J-22, J-24, Thistle, Laser, Star, Snipe, Dragon, Arcom, Lightning for the CYC Regatta. Any class not listed above may contact the organizers to request their class' inclusion.
- 3.3 Cruising Division Series will be offered for PHRF, JAM, T-10, R. and boats and cruising class divisions.
- 3.4 Keelboats completing the registration as required in section 5 and section 7 of this notice shall enter eligible boats.

**5. REGISTRATION**

- 5.1 All boats shall register by completing the designated One Design or Cruising Division Registration Form attached. Completed forms shall be mailed with the appropriate rating or measurement certificate(s) and fees to:

Email registration 'reservations' will be accepted. This form can be emailed to [n\\_cottone@yahoo.com](mailto:n_cottone@yahoo.com). Boats registering by email will not be formally registered until payment is received. Please mail in your payment to complete the registration process.

- 5.2 Late registration for the all classes entering the CYC Regatta or the Lighthouse Series will be accepted until 9:00 p.m. on Friday, June 14<sup>th</sup> with the exception of One Design. One design competitors may late register until 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, June 15, 2001.
- 5.3 Late registration yachts entering the Roberts race only will be accepted until 6:00 p.m. on Friday, June 21, 2001 at the club. In this case, yachts must call the Committee to notify them of their intent to late register for the Roberts Race. Messages can be left at #216-272-8286.

**6. FEES**

6.1 Registration Fees: will be based on Early and Late Registration Dates and linear foot measurements of the overall length of the vessel as marked on their rating certificate. To qualify for early registration, entry fee's must be received or postmarked by 6/01/02. Late registration fees will be in effect after 6/02/02. Fee's may be paid by cash, check or club chit.

**7. MEASUREMENT**

- 7.1 Each One-Design boat must conform to its class rules. The CYC Regatta may serve as a special event for a specific class or classes. In such cases, the individual class may require more specific measurement or registration criteria, which shall be addressed by a separate Notice of Race specific to those special class events.
- 7.2 Each PHRF and Jam entrant must submit a valid 2002 PHRF-LE rating certificate with the registration form and fees.

**8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

Sailing Instructions for all races in the Lighthouse Series will be included in the Skipper's Packet. Skipper's Packets will be available at The Cleveland Yachting Club on Friday, June 14<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. for all Regatta and Lighthouse Series entrants. Packets for Roberts Race (only) participants will be available on Friday, June 21<sup>st</sup> from 5:00 pm to 6:30 p.m.

**9. RACING AREAS**

## DRAFT

- 9.1 One-Design Series sailing on June 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> will take place on two separate courses, both set Northwest of the Rocky River on Lake Erie. Class assignments and course locations will be included with the Sailing Instructions.
- 9.2 Cruising Division Series sailing on June 15<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup> will be started on the CYC course. With the exception of the Roberts Race, all cruising courses will utilize CYC fixed course marks and/or tetrahedrons for course changes.
- 9.3 The Roberts Race will start between the committee boat and the CYC “S” mark and utilize fixed and set marks as will be described in the skipper’s packet.

## 10. SCORING

- 10.1 The Low Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A2, will apply.
- 10.2 The CYC Regatta One Design Series will have one throw-out race if at least 4 races are sailed. The Cruising Class Series will have no throw-out races for the CYC Regatta or the Lighthouse Series. Note: Thursday Night June 20<sup>th</sup> race is not a qualifier for the series.
- 10.3 The Lighthouse Series Committee, at its sole discretion, whose decision is final, shall determine eligibility and placement within divisions and fleet sub assignments for the Cruising Division Series.

## 11. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for first, second & third place finishes in class or division for the Lighthouse Series and CYC Regatta. Additional awards will also be given for Solstice Race and the Roberts Race. Daily awards will also be given for each division.

## 12. GUEST DOCKAGE AND LAUNCHING

- 12.1 No boats can be accommodated for dockage for the Cruising Class Series before Wednesday, June 12<sup>th</sup>. Dockage will be available for boats registered for the CYC Regatta through June 22<sup>nd</sup> and for the Lighthouse Series through June 27<sup>th</sup>. Boats that are unregistered will be charged for dockage subject to availability at CYC’s normal rates. Visiting boats seeking to dock at CYC must contact Lamont Butler, Harbormaster, to be assigned dockage. Rafting will be required for all fleets.
- 12.2 All One Design Keelboats must be launched at least one hour before the 1<sup>st</sup> warning signal. No One Design Keelboat shall be hauled out of the water until the last race of the regatta, unless the Race Committee or the Protest Committee has given prior written authorization to the skipper, or to settle a protest.

## 13. FURTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 13.1 **Parking** – Due to the anticipated high traffic expected for the Regatta, as well as other activities planned on the island, parking will be limited to those with a 2002 Series Parking Permit or CYC Club members with valid 2002 stickers. All others should use the offsite parking at DAWSON’s Business Building located within walking distance from the top of hill above the Club at 1310 Depot Str., Rocky River. A free Shuttle service will be provided. Skippers are encouraged to car pool.
  - 13.1.1 Off-Island Parking – A map and directions to DAWSONS is attached. See Below. Cars will not be allowed down Yacht Club Drive without a CYC sticker or Regatta Parking Pass.
  - 13.1.2 Parking on the Island – will be limited to vehicles with a 2002 Series Parking Permit or CYC Club members with valid 2002 stickers
    - 13.1.2.1.1 Friday, 6/14- Parking will be allowed on the island for the Registration Party for skippers and crews.
    - 13.1.2.1.2 Saturday 6/15, Sunday, 6/16 – Parking Permit holders must park at the south end of the island regardless of where your boat is docked.
    - 13.1.2.1.3 6/17-6/22 – Parking on the island will be available to skippers and

crews.

- 13.1.3 Trailerable Boat Parking – One Design fleets can bring in trailerable boats starting on Thursday, 6/13/02. Lasers shall use the north grass area of the island to launch, while all other fleets should use the south end of the island to launch. It is preferable that trailers be removed from the island during the regatta, but it is not required. You may be asked to move your trailer off-island during the regatta if the need arises.
- 13.2 **Shuttle Service** – CYC will provide Shuttle Service on Saturday, 6/15 and Sunday, 6/16 during the Regatta. The shuttle will pick up on the island by the Guardhouse at entrance to the club and drop off at the parking area.

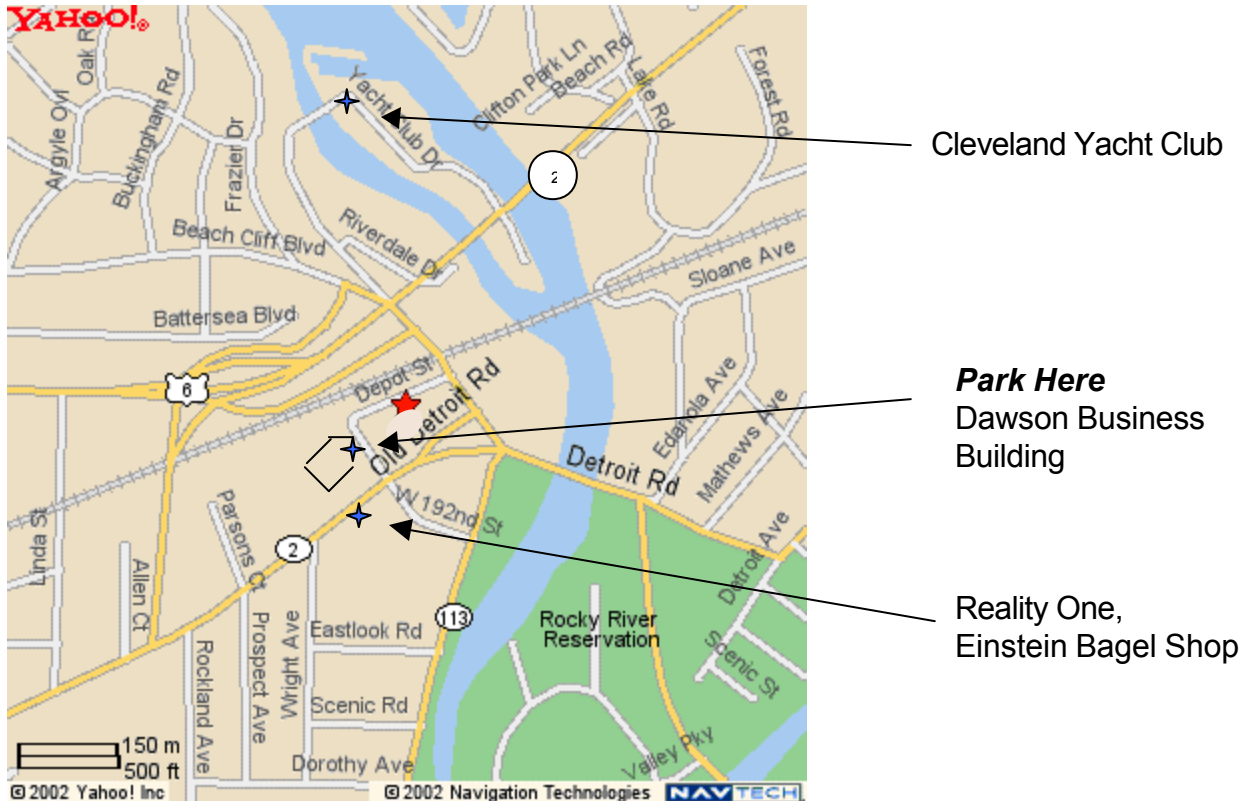

## Off Site Parking and Shuttle Instructions:

Due to heavy car volume expected on the island, all crew and visiting club members are required to park off site. Parking and shuttle service will be provided for your convenience for Saturday and Sunday of the CYC Regatta on 6/15-16 as part of the lighthouse Series. Parking will be allowed on the island for the Wednesday Summer Solstice Race on 6/19 and the Roberts Race on Friday, 6/21.

Crews can be dropped off either at the top of Yacht Club Drive, near the CYC sign and walk down the hill or use the shuttle service. **Cars without a CYC 2002 sticker or Regatta parking pass will not be allowed down Yacht Club Drive.**

Parking is available for all crew and visiting club members at the Dawson Business Building. Although shuttles will be provided, **this is within walking distance to the club**

Directions to parking lot from CYC:

- Go South on Beachcliff Dr. to Detroit Road. At the stoplight, take a right on Detroit. Make another right onto Depot Street. At the bend on the road, take a left into the Beachcliff Plaza. Dawson will be directly ahead of you.
